The **Newport Beach Police Department** has requested **no stops during the Parade**. It needs to have a continuous forward movement. Due to the popularity of the Parade and to avoid lengthy traffic disruption, any group stopping for greater than 30 seconds will be disqualified from the judging.

Routines of any type, dance, exercise, etc. must follow these guidelines. Any that do not, will be disqualified from the judging. Should the pauses or stopping for greater than 30 seconds or occur more than three (3) times during the Parade, the entry will not be invited to participate in future parades.

We want everyone to have fun and enjoy the day, but keep in mind **safety is important**. There are children of all ages lining the parade route. **If you plan on giving out candy or other trinkets, please have those distributing it, hand it to the parade viewers**. Tossing it could hurt someone. If you are driving a vehicle in the parade, please be mindful of small children, and drive slowly and carefully.
